2025 ICUA YOUTH RALLY COMPETITION GENERAL RULES

- 1. Contest is open to all high school sophomores and juniors, or the equivalent, whose parents or guardians are members of Idaho County Light & Power Cooperative and presently receive electric service from the cooperative.
- 2. All contestants will be required to submit an essay on the subject, "An accomplishment I have experienced and how it has impacted my life." The essay can be handwritten in ink or typed but must be no more than 400 words in length. The essay must be the contestant's own original creation. The essay will be judged on the basis of knowledge of Content, Organization, Voice (writer's personality & creativity), Word Choice and Mechanics. Do not print your name on the essay. Do print your name and address on a separate sheet attached to the essay.
- 3. The completed essay, along with a completed official Application Form and Biographical Information Sheet, must be received in the cooperative's office or through email, iclp@iclp.coop, by April 14, 2025.
- 4. Authors of the <u>eight</u> (8) highest-scoring essays will be selected for personal interviews. All contestants must be available for a personal interview on Thursday, April 24th between 3:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.
- 5. Final selection of winners will be based on the total combined scores of the essay and the personal interview.
- 6. Winners agree to represent Idaho County Light & Power at the 2025 ICUA Youth Rally, July 7 through 11th. The Rally will be at Northwest Nazarene University, Nampa, Idaho. All expenses will be paid by the cooperative. The ICL&P delegates will compete with other 2025 Youth Rally delegates to be selected as the Idaho Representative to the NRECA National Youth Tour in Washington, D.C. Expenses for the National Youth Tour are paid by the ICUA.
- 7. <u>Winners agree</u> to attend and participate in the Idaho County Light & Power Cooperative Annual Membership Meeting on <u>November 6th</u>. Winners also may be asked to represent the cooperative at other times, as deemed appropriate by the board of directors or management.
